Clay Tiles Workshop

This workshop will encourage participants to explore nature and show how it can be incorporated to teach classic printing skills and ceramic relief work. Participants will collect pieces of nature - for example, leaves, flowers, shells - to incorporate into the design of their tile. They will be guided step by step through the design process from deciding on a shape, painting and how to seal the tile so that it's watertight.

Once you have registered (by 11th June), supply packs containing clay, paint, paintbrushes and a wire clay cutter will be available to collect from a specified store in Tralee. Participants will also need a dry sheet to place on a table they can work from, a jar of water, a bowl, a rolling pin and skewers.
